Instructions for Candidates

1. Nearest available examination centers will be allotted and informed to the candidate based on their address. Candidates will report to their respective examination centre on **14th June 2026** at **10:30 AM**.
2. **Admit cards will be issued at the examination centres.**
3. Examination will be conducted on **14th June 2026** from **11:30 AM to 1:00 PM** at allotted Examination Centers.
4. Candidates are required to deposit **cash Rs. 100/-** (Rs. One Hundred Only) to the examination center staff to receive their admit cards.
5. Students appearing for prelims examination are required to show and submit a **self-attested copy of aadhar card** to the invigilator.
6. Candidates will be given an **undertaking form at the centre which they have to fill and submit to the invigilator without fail.**
7. Candidates are required to write his/her roll number, name, father's name and exam centre on the top of the answer sheet and on the question paper.
8. All your personal belongings (such as bags, pouches, ear/headphones, laptops etc.) must be placed outside of the examination hall. Please do not bring any valuable belongings except the essential materials required for the examinations.
9. You are allowed to bring transparent water bottles in the examination hall.
10. Any unauthorized materials, such as books, calculators, paper, documents, pictures and electronic devices with communication and/or storage capabilities such as tablet PC, laptop, smart watch, portable audio/video/gaming devices etc. are not to be brought into the examination hall.
11. The University will not be responsible for the loss of any belongings in or outside the examination hall.
12. **The candidates are allowed to enter the Examination Hall 30 minutes prior to**

the commencement of the Examination. The Answer Sheets would be distributed before the actual time prescribed for the commencement of Examination to enable the candidates to study the instructions printed therein and to enter certain particulars. It would, therefore, be in the interest of the candidate to report on time.

13. **The candidate will not be allowed to enter the examination hall if he /she comes 10 minutes late after the start of the examination.**
14. All materials and/or devices which are found to violate any of the examination regulations will be confiscated.
15. You are not allowed to communicate by word of mouth or otherwise with other candidates.
16. Please raise your hand if you wish to communicate with an invigilator.
17. Unless granted permission by an invigilator, you are not allowed to leave your seat.
18. Once you have entered the examination hall, you will not be allowed to leave the hall after the examination has commenced.
19. All candidates must remain seated throughout this period for invigilators to properly account for all answer sheets to be collected.
20. At the conclusion of the examination, you are to stop writing and remain seated quietly while your answer sheets are being collected and counted.
21. No supplementary sheets will be provided to the student.
22. After you have completed filling in all responses on the answer sheet and the examination has concluded, **you should hand over the following to the Invigilator:**
 - i. **Answer sheet**
 - ii. **Aadhaar Card Self-attested copy**
 - iii. **Student Undertaking form**
 - iv. **Admit Card**You are permitted to take away with you the question paper booklet.
